

CSW Broadband Launches Wave 1 with New Map – December 2015

The first cabinets to be upgraded under Contract 2, Part 1 of the CSW Broadband project have been announced. Thousands more Warwickshire homes and businesses are to benefit from the multi-million pound extension of superfast fibre broadband when engineering work starts, giving another 14,600 homes and businesses access to fibre broadband.

Engineers from Openreach – BT's local network business – will begin installing the new network in January. The first premises will be able to access fibre broadband from Summer 2016, reaching 3,600 additional homes and businesses by the end of 2016, and the majority of the remainder by the end of 2018.

It's around 18 months since CSW Broadband started connecting the first premises in Warwickshire, Solihull and Coventry to faster fibre broadband. Since then, Openreach engineers have installed more than 220 new road-side cabinets, making fibre available to more than 43,000 homes and businesses.

The team have been working hard to bring more detailed mapping, and the latest version takes things to a different level – literally! New features include:

- Postcode and line-checker searches
- Zooming directly to your property
- Street-level details with road names
- Area-level information showing where you are in the build pipeline
- Property-level connectivity information

PLEASE NOTE: The property-level connectivity is still in its infancy. There are over 500,000 properties in the CSW Broadband database and the team need you to check your property and to report back if there are any inaccuracies. This will help CSW Broadband to improve the data still further for future iterations of the map.
